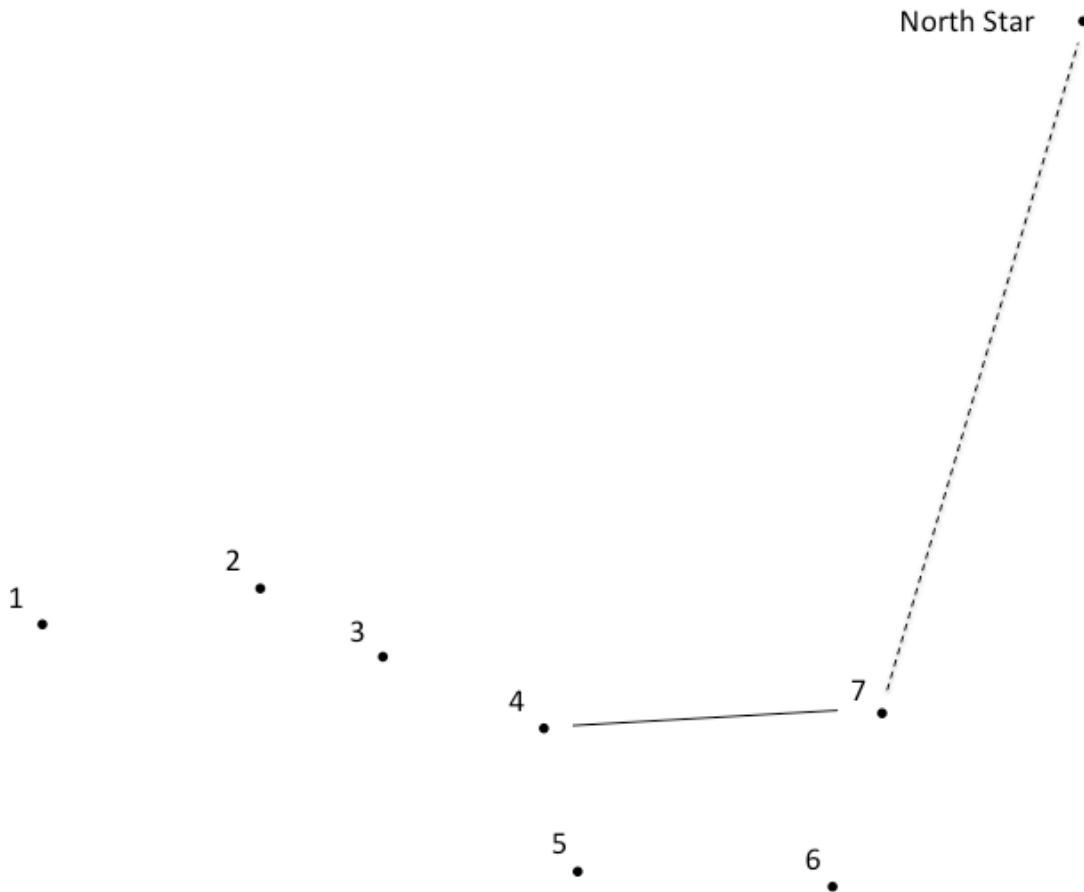
5. Visit a planetarium or view stars at night. Locate the North Star.
